CHAP. CXII.

Passed Mar 6, 1820 *An Act for the destruction of Wolves and Panthers, in Allegany County.*

Allowance for killing them

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall and may be lawful for the justices of the levy court of Allegany county, to allow such sum as in their skill and judgment they may think right and proper, in addition to the sum already allowed by law, for every old or young wolf or panther, caught and killed within the limits of Allegany county; *Provided* such additional compensation shall not exceed the sum of five dollars.

CHAP. CXIII.

Passed Mar 6, 1820 *An Act to exempt the Property of the Grand Lodge of Maryland from taxation.*

Property exempt from taxation

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the lot of ground and buildings thereon, situate on the east side of St. Paul's Lane in the city of Baltimore, now owned and held by the Grand Lodge of the State of Maryland, and all the personal property belonging to said Grand Lodge in the state of Maryland, be exempt, and the same are hereby exempted, from taxation and public assessment; *Provided* the same shall continue to be the property or estate of the Grand Lodge of Maryland aforesaid, any thing to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.

CHAP. CXIV.

Passed Mar 6, 1820 *A Further Supplement to the act, entitled, An act relating to the City of Baltimore.*

Ordinances relating to appointments

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the mayor and city council of Baltimore may pass ordinances regulating the manner of appointing persons to office under said corporation, which they are now or may hereafter be authorised by law to appoint, any thing in the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, to the contrary notwithstanding.
