CHAP. CLXXVI.

An Act for the relief of Mary Beckly, of Washington County.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma. Marriage contract ryland, That from and after the passage of this act, the mare ryland, That from Marry Rocking and House Rocking.

ryland, That from and after the passage of this act, the marriage contract between Mary Beckly and Henry Beckly, is hereby declared to be annulled and destroyed, and the said Mary Beckly is hereby declared to be divorced from her husband Henry Beckly, as entirely and to as full extent, as if the said Henry Beckly were dead, or as if she, the said Mary Beckly, had never been joined in matrimony with him.

CHAP. CLXXVII.

An Act to exempt the Mount Hope Literary and Scien-Pauce Mar 13,1000 tific Institution from Taxation.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-Lous and buildings ryland, That the lot and buildings thereon, belonging to tion the Mount Hope Literary and Scientific Institution in Baltimore county, and partly in the city of Baltimore, and the library, and other property of the said institution, shall be and the same is hereby exempted from taxation, for the term of ten years; Provided, the said lot and buildings shall so long continue to be used as a literary institution.

CHAP. CLXXVIII.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to incorporate vaned New 13,1866
the Port Deposit and Chesapeake Turnpike Road
Company.

Sec. 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-Repeat ryland, That so much of the act, to which this is a supplement, as requires the stockholders in the Port Deposit and Chesapeako Turnpike Road Company, to meet on the first Monday in May eighteen hundred and twenty-nine, and on the first Monday in May in each succeeding year, he and same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2: And be it enwoted, That the said stockholders beid on the first half meet on the first Monday in May in the year eighteen monday in as hundred and thirty-one, and on the first Monday in May in each succeeding year thereafter, and the said stockholders are hereby authorised and empowered to meet at any time or times, to be by them, or a majority of them, determined, previous to the first Monday of May eighteen hundred and thirty-one, to perform and discharge the duties required of them by the act in which this is a supplement
