CHAP. 194.

An Act for the Revaluation of the Real and Personal Property in Charles County.

Passed Mar 15, 1828

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the commissioners of the tax for Charles county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to meet at the county town of said county, as soon as may be practicable after the passage of this act, and there proceed to revalue and reassess the real and personal property of said county, agreeably to the provisions of an act, passed at November session eighteen hundred and twelve, entitled, An act for the valuation of real and personal property in the several counties of this state; and the said commissioners are hereby authorised and empowered, to carry into full effect and operation, within the said county, all the provisions of the aforesaid act of eighteen hundred and twelve.

CHAP. CXCIV.

An Act to authorise Samuel Peaco, of the City of Annapolis, to have recorded a Deed, therein mentioned, and for other purposes.

Passed Mar 13, 1828

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall and may be lawful for Samuel Peaco, of the city of Annapolis, to have a certain deed of conveyance between John Ireland, late of Anne-Arundel county, deceased, of the one part, and the said Samuel Peaco, of the city of Annapolis, of the other part, and dated the eighth day of November, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety-one, recorded among the land records of Anne-Arundel county court; and upon such recording the said deed shall be firm and valid, to all intents and purposes whatever; and the property thereby intended to be conveyed, shall vest in the said Samuel Peaco, as fully and amply, to all intents and purposes, as if the said deed had been recorded according to law; *Provided,* that nothing in this act contained shall operate or be construed so as to interfere with, or in anywise affect, the rights of third persons, acquired to the property mentioned in said deed, between the execution of the same, and the passage of this law.

CHAP. CXCVE.

An Act for the relief of Jacob Hoblitzell, of Allegany County, and for other purposes.

Passed Mar 14, 1828

Sec. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That any suit, in which the state is a party, now pending in Allegany county court against the said Jacob Hoblitzell, for obstructing the road, for which he is presented in Allegany county court, shall be discontinued, and no farther proceedings shall be had, on behalf of the state,
