Lusby, and his securities, with forty days from the passage of this resolution, give bond to the state, with two good and sufficient additional securities, to be taken and approved by the treasure of the eastern shore, for the payment of such sum as may now be due to the state by said Robert C. Lusby, and his securities.

Priord Mar 14,1005 A Resolution providing for the payment of Hohne and Malonee, for washing the Windows of the Chambers of the Senate and House of Delegates.

Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore, be and he is hereby suthorised and directed, to pay to Hohne and Malones, or their order, the sum of eight dollars, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, for washing the windows of the chambers of the senate and house of delegates.
