FENCES.	Partition fences between adjoining fields to be repaired at the joint expense of the persons respectively owning the fields, The acts of 1826, ch. 81, and 1827, ch. 150, respecting fences in Charles and Allegany counties, repealed,	101 101
FERRIES.	A ferry to be established on Pocomoke river from Pollitt's Landing in Somerset county, to the landing on the Worcester county side of said river,	35
FIERI FACIAS.	See Executions.	
FINES & FORFEITURES.	Persons who shall ride, &c. upon the pavement of the side walks in the village of Liberty in Frederick county, to be fined, &c. No execution shall issue for any fine, where the person fined shall give security for the payment thereof and costs, until after the expiration of sixty days, The clerk of the court, upon the money being tendered to him for any fine imposed, shall receive the fine and costs, and pay over the same to the sheriff, who shall pay the fine into the treasury, A fine imposed on the clerk of Queen-Anne's county court on refusal to deliver to the clerk of the levy court of that county, the books, &c. belonging to the levy court, The like on the clerk of Anne-Arundel county court, A penalty imposed on any person who may cut or injure the rope attached to the ferry-boat used on the ferry of Pocomoke river, A fine to be imposed on the overseer of the streets in Cambridge for not keeping them in good repair, — For exacting improper tolls for passing over the bridge to be built over Potomac river at Noland's Ferry, and on persons attempting to pass without paying, A penalty imposed on any person who shall, in Nottingham, confine in any pen,	8 11 11 14 21 36 43 47
