LOTTERIES.

Chap.

any ticket in any lottery, other than such as have been granted by the state and approved, &c. or shall be aiding, &c.

— Also on persons offering to sell any ticket in any lottery authorised by this state, &c. or shall be aiding, &c. unless he has obtained a license for that purpose,

Persons obtaining such license offending, &c. his license to be null and void, &c.

Ib.

Regulations respecting trials relative to the sale of lottery tickets, &c.

Ib.

Penalty for offering for sale any articles, money, goods, lands, &c. to be determined by lot, chance, or the drawing of any lottery; or for selling, &c. any policy, &c. But not to affect licensed vendors of lottery tickets,

Punishment for altering or forging any lottery ticket, &c.

Ib.

Courts to construe this act largely and strongly against offenders,

On the suggestion of the lottery commissioners, &c. proceedings in any prosecution may be transferred to any adjoining county court for trial,

Ib.

There shall be no prosecutions for violations of the former lottery laws; and if any such prosecutions are now depending they are to be dismissed, &c.

Ib.

The county courts and Baltimore city court to give this act in charge to their respective grand juries,

Ib.

Certain sections of the act of 1827, ch. 160, made applicable to certain sections of this act,

The 3d section of the act of 1825, ch. 210, and all acts, &c. repugnant to this act, repealed,

The commissioners to call on the attorney general to sue out injunctions to restrain the drawing of any lottery not authorised, &c.
