SCHOOL FUND.	The act of 1827, ch. 43, directing the treasurer to pay to the commissioners of primary schools for Queen-Anne's county, the interest accruing on the school fund invested for the use of the county, repealed, — The commissioners of the school fund for Queen-Anne's county, directed how to apply the interest of the sums invested by them in bank stock, and the funds which they may receive from the treasurer. They are directed to pay over to the commissioners of primary schools for the county the sums which may be apportioned among the districts, &c. — See Deford, John, and The act for the encouragement of primary schools in Anne-Arundel county, 1827, ch. 173, except the 2d section, repealed, and the treasurer required to invest so much of the school fund of the county as shall produce a capital of \$5000 to be held for the use of the primary schools, the dividends of which to be deposited in the Farmers Bank of Maryland, to the credit of the commissioners of the primary schools.
