CHAPTER 12.

Enacted Jan 21, 1830 *An act supplemental to an act, entitled, 'an act for the regulation and improvement of the village of Denton, in Caroline county.*

Permission to sit up.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That James Sangston, John Brown, Nehemiah Fountain, Bennett Wherrett and James Hand, the Commissioners of the village of Denton, their successors or a majority of them, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, to build or fit up a room or rooms within the market house in said village of Denton, as they, or a majority of them, may think proper: *Provided,* That a sufficiency of space be still left in said market house, to accommodate such persons as bring articles of marketing into said village

Other cases, &c.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said commissioners or a majority of them, are hereby authorized to rent, let or lease out, the room or rooms as aforesaid, when completed, and collect by warrant or otherwise, according to law, from any person or persons to whom said room or rooms may be rented or leased, or who may occupy the same, such rent or rents, and the money when collected, to be appropriated as is directed by the act to which this is a supplement.

CHAPTER 13.

Passed Jan 21, 1830 *An act to change the time of holding the November term of Somerset county Court.*

This provided.

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, the County Court for Somerset county, shall be held on the third Monday in May and the third Monday in November, for and every year; and that all causes, pleas, process and proceedings, civil and criminal, returnable to, or depending before the County Court, shall be returnable to the third Monday in May and the third Monday in November, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
