That each assessor, before he shall proceed to the execution of his day, under this act, shall severally take an oath, that he will hit cently, farthfully, and will tainfully and impartially value all property which he shall be appointed to value, accorning to the best of his skill and judzment, at its full eash value, as if the same were clear of all membraness; and that he will perform and fulli all the requisitions of this set, as far as the same shall appertain to the proper duties of his acquaintent which said oath shall be administered by any one of the roo missioners and a memorandum of the same recorded among their proceedings.

Penalty for ne-

Sec. 3. And be it caused. That if any person appointed an assessor in virtue of this act, and who shall accept of the said appointment shall neglect to make the required returns agreeably to this act, and the instructions given him in conformity thereto, he shall for every such neglect, if wilful, forfeit and pay the sum of one hundred dollars for the use of the said county, to be collected by suit in the name of the levy court of said county, against such delinquent assessor.
