Compensation

Section 1. Be it enoted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Irustrees of the poor in Worcester county, of every day they may actually be employed in the discharge of their duties as Trustrees as aforesaid, shall be entitled to the sum of one dollar and fifty cents each.

Sec. 2. And be it curried. That the levy court of Worcester county, be, and they are hereby authorised and directed, to levy and assess on the assessable property of said county, a sum sufficient for the parament of the said trustees as aforesaid.
