Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Vayor and City Council of Baltimore shall hereafter have and possers, full power to pass all ordinances necessary for grading, recutating, passing and repairing the foot-ways, in the streets, lanes and alleys of the city of Baltimore, and to impose a lax on any lot or lots, fronting on any pavel street, lane or alley, within the said city, for the purpose of grading, regulating, pasting or repairing the foot-ways in front thereof, or to compel by fine or otherwise, the proprietor or proprietors of any lot or lots to pave or repair the foot ways in front thereof, agreeably to the ordinances to be passed upon the subject.
