CHAP. 130.

An act authorising the appointment of a Trustee for the urpose Processistants
of making a conveyance for a certain piece of land therein
mentioned, to Isaac Williams, of Cecil County.

Section I. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That John Ash, of Cecil counts, be and he is hereby ap, omed # Trustee, with power to convey to skase Williams one half acre of land bordering on the nain road leading to Elkton, and being on the extreme line of the farm of the late William Whittam, being the same half acre which was heretotore purchased by the said Isaac Williams, from the said William Whittam.

CHAPTER 131.

An act to fix the compensation of Jurors in Queen Ann's Panel February.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Astembly of Maryland, That each and every jurus hereafter to be summoned on the regular pannel of jurus to Queen Am.'s Count Court, shall be entitled to receive for each day which he shain as no as a juror, the sum of one dollar and tifty cards, and in anticion thereto, an allowance of six and a quarter cents per not, for every mile that his place of residence shall be distint from the place of holding the County Court; and to be levied, of bested, and pant, in the same manner, and at the same time, with his per diem allowance; and he shall be entitled to receive mineage for each day, who juror shall attend the cour.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That nothing contained in the Explanter addregoing section shall be construed to allow any juror muchage in returning to his residence, during the time he shall at-

age in returning to his retend said county court.

CHAPTER 132.

An act relating to the records in the Register of Wills' office, records in Caroline county.

WHEREAS: it is represented to this General Assembly, by Promobine petition of James Sangston, Register of Wills for Caroline county, that certain records in his office, commonly called "Key to Administrations, and Key to Guardiaushis," have become much injured and desaced, and hause to occome hoally lost, therefore,
