An act to authorise the Gorernor and Council to appoint an In- Prince Feb 23,830 spector of Lumber for the village of Arkhaven, in Cecil enuatu

Section 1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council of this state be, and they be are hereby authorised and required to a mount one measurer and inspector of houser for the village of Arkhaven, in Cecil county, which said measurer and inspector shall be governed by the same laws with regard to his measurement and inspection, which govern the inspectors of lumber in the city of Baltimore, and that he shall be allowed twenty cents for measuring and inspecting every thousand feet, reduced measure. which said fees shall be paid by the person requiring the lumber to be inspected.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That before the said measurer Out. and inspector shall proceed to act as such, he shall take an eath or attirmation, as the case may be, faithfully to perform his duty as measurer and inspector of lumber for said village.
