CHAPTER 159

An act to nuclearise the instices of the Orphans' and Levy Passed Feb 27,330 Conce of Docemeter County, to appoint their respective Criers.

Section 1. Be it careful by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Justices of the Dichard and Levy Courts for Dorchester county, re-pectively, be, and they are hereby authorised, to appoint their Criers, from and after the first day of April next.

Sec 2. And be it enacted. That the Levy Court for Dorches- 100 - compe ter county is hereby authorised and directed to levy on the assessable property of said county, annually, a sum of money for the use of the Criers aforesaid, not exceeding one dollar per day for every day that the Register of Wills, and Clerk of the County, shall certify that the said Crier acted as such.
