Sec. 8. And be it matted. That no volunteer brigade which

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That so much of the proviso to the first section of the act to which this is a supplement, as enacts that "the person or persons in whose name or names, any such goods, wares, or marchandine, are so shipped or consigned, shall be taken
