Any person (except in the city of Baltimore,) thinking themselves aggrieved, &c., may appeal at any time within sixty days of the date of such magistrates' judgment; provided they give bond &c. to prosecute said appeal, at the next succeeding county court, &c.; which appeal shall have the same effect as a superseas, &c., as if the appeal bond had been filed, as now required by law; and the county court shall hear and determine &c.	236	1
