The exporter of any such parcels of tobacco, shall mark them with the weight they contain, under oath, the state in which the tobacco was grown, and the number of the smallest of the hogshead from which the same may have been taken

No clerk or other person employed by any of the inspectors of, shall buy or in any way deal in, or busy himself in procuring tobacoo to be sold or consigned, or in loading any vessel with, etc. under the penalty of \$16 for every hogsbead, etc.
