CHAP. 120

An act to regulate the sale of Ardent Spirits, within the vil. Paned Feb. 20,121 lage of Salisbury, in Somerset and Worcester Counties.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Restricting lice from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful for the clerk of Somerset County Court, or the clerk of Worcester County Court, to issue a license to any person or persons to sell ardent spirits, at any place within the village of Salisbury, in the counties of Somerset and Worcester, or within one and a half miles of said village, without an order in writing from one of the Judges of the County Court of Somerset or Worcester County, who is hereby authorised to grant such order, if he shall be satisfied from the representation of twelve or more respectable inhabitants of said village, of the necessity and propriety of granting such license, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 120.

An act to provide for the Inspection of Flour, Leamber, and Panel Feb. 11,1215 Coal, in the Town of Williams port, in Washington Countų.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-Appoint ryland, That the Governor and Council shall appoint, on or before the first Monday of April next, and annually thereafter, or oftener, if necessary, an Inspector of flour, for Williamsport in Washington county.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That every Inspector of flour, Dath who shall be appointed for Williamsport, shall on his appointment, and before executing the duties of said office, make outh or affirmation, as the case may be, before some justice of the peace in and for Washington county, that without fear, favor, affection, malice, partiality or respect of persons, he will diligently and carefully view, examine, and inspect all flour, brought to the said Town of Williamsport, which he shall be called upon to view, examine and inspect to the best of his skill, knowledge and ability, and that no
