CHAP. 120

An act to regulate the sale of Ardent Spirits, within the village of Salisbury, in Somerset and Worcester Counties. Passed Feb. 20, 1834

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Restricting licen-
 from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful
 for the clerk of Somerset County Court, or the clerk of
 Worcester County Court, to issue a license to any person or
 persons to sell ardent spirits, at any place within the village
 of Salisbury, in the counties of Somerset and Worcester, or
 within one and a half miles of said village, without an order
 in writing from one of the Judges of the County Court of
 Somerset or Worcester County, who is hereby authorised
 to grant such order, if he shall be satisfied from the repre-
 sentation of twelve or more respectable inhabitants of said
 village, of the necessity and propriety of granting such
 license, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

CHAPTER 120.

An act to provide for the Inspection of Flour, Lumber, and Coal, in the Town of Williamsport, in Washington County. Passed Feb. 23, 1834

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma-* Appointment of
 ryland, That the Governor and Council shall appoint, on flour inspector
 or before the first Monday of April next, and annually
 thereafter, or oftener, if necessary, an Inspector of flour,
 for Williamsport in Washington county.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That every Inspector of flour, Oath required-
 who shall be appointed for Williamsport, shall on his duties
 appointment, and before executing the duties of said office,
 make oath or affirmation, as the case may be, before some
 justice of the peace in and for Washington county, that
 without fear, favor, affection, malice, partiality or respect of
 persons, he will diligently and carefully view, examine, and
 inspect all flour, brought to the said Town of Williamsport,
 which he shall be called upon to view, examine and inspect
 to the best of his skill, knowledge and ability, and that no
