Duty

the flour in question, and to compare the same with the said standard, and if they or any two of them, upon such comparison shall reverse the judgment so appealed from, the inspector, whose judgment is so reversed, shall put on the cask or casks containing the aforesaid flour, such brand as the aforesaid three persons, or any two of them, shall declare to be agreeable to the said standard.

Inspectors of lumber and coal

Sec. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the Governor and Council shall, immediately on the passage of this act, and in every year thereafter, appoint one measurer and inspector of lumber, and a measurer of coal, for the said Town of Williamsport, who before they shall proceed to act in virtue of their appointment, shall take the oath or affirmation, as the case may be, as prescribed in the second section of this act, a certificate whereof shall be filed, as is provided for in the second section of this act.

Their deputies

Sec. 16. *And be it enacted*, That the said inspector and measurer shall each have power to appoint one deputy, who shall hold his office during the pleasure of the principal inspector or measurer, and no longer, and before he acts as such, shall take the same oath or affirmation required to be taken by the second section of this act; a certificate whereof shall be filed as is provided for in the second section of this act.

Their province

Sec. 17. *And be it enacted*, That when any person may want lumber or coal inspected and measured, he shall notify the said inspector and measurer, whose duty it shall be immediately thereafter to inspect and measure the same; *Provided*, that nothing herein contained, shall be construed to compel any person to have his or their lumber or coal measured or inspected, but that all persons wishing it, shall have it done by the measurer or inspector appointed, and if any person receive pay therefor without being appointed by the Governor and Council as aforesaid, and contrary to the true intent and meaning of this act, such person or persons so offending, shall forfeit and pay the sum of twenty dollars, for each and every offence, to be recovered in the name of the Burgess and Commissioners of the Town of Williamsport, for the use of the Town.

And prerogative

Regulations prescribed

Sec. 18. *And be it enacted*, That the measurer and proprietor of lumber, shall be guided in all respects in regard to the inspection, measuring, and marking the same, by the same rules and regulations prescribed in the act of Assembly, entitled an Act for the inspection of lumber, passed at November session, eighteen hundred and eleven, chapter seventy, and the supplements thereto; and shall be entitled
