CHAPTER 148.

Passed Mar. 5, 1835 *An act supplementary to an act, entitled, An act to Incorporate the Savings Institution of Emmettsburg.*

Five directors

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in all future elections under the act to which this is a supplement, five Directors shall be elected to manage the concerns of the corporation; and that so much of the said act as requires the election of nine Directors, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 149.

Passed Mar. 4, 1835 *An act to alter and change the name of John Kemp, of Talbot County, to that of John Washington Kemp.*

Name changed

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name of John Kemp, of Talbot county, be and is hereby altered and changed unto the name of John Washington Kemp, and it shall and may be lawful for the said John Kemp, at all times hereafter, to be called and known by, and hold and use the name of John Washington Kemp, and by that name to sue and be sued, in any court of law or equity.*

Acts confirmed

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted, That all securities, promises, contracts, assurances, deeds and lawful acts whatsoever, hereafter to be made and done by the name of John Washington Kemp, shall be of the same force and effect, and equally avail to all intents and purposes, as if the name of John Washington Kemp had been the original and proper name of the said John Kemp.*
