ested persons, qualified to act as jurors in the County court, to meet upon the land, and after four are stricken off the pannel, by the President or his agent, and four by the person or persons interested, in his, her, or their, absence or refusal by the sheriff, the said sheriff shall qualify the remaining twelve jurors, either by oath or affirmation, as the case may be, justly, truly, and impartially, to value the damages, which may be sustained by the owner, or owners of such materials or land, required by the said company; and the said jurors shall, after valuing said damages, return the same under their hands and seals, to the clerk of Frederick county court, to be by him recorded, and said damages shall be paid by the company, into the hands of the sheriff of the said county, for the persons mentioned in said return respectively, before the said company shall proceed to remove said materials, or use the said land for the said road. The justice, sheriff, and clerk, shall be entitled to receive the same fees, for services rendered under this act, as they are allowed on similar cases; and the persons summoned as jurors shall each receive one dollar per day, during their attendance, which fees and allowances, shall be paid by the said company; and the said company or their agents shall have power to remove said materials across any land, not in meadow, or grain, upon paying a reasonable compensation, to the owner or owners, for any injury or damages, to be ascertained by a jury, as above, in case the same cannot be obtained by agreement.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That for making said road, subscription books for a capital stock of eighty thousand dollars, in four thousand shares, at twenty dollars each, to be opened in Emmittsburg, Taneytown, and Westminster aforesaid, by or under the directions of all, or any of the following commissioners to wit: Doct. James A. Shorb, Lewis Motter, Christian Correll, Joseph Danner, Isaac Bougher, Samuel Galt, William Shaw, John B. Boyle, Doct. William B. Gwinn, Doct. John Swope, Jacob Matthias, Isaac Shriver, Abraham Wampler, Jacob Reese, and Joshua Cockey, on the first Monday in April next, and continue open for three days inclusive, and in the event of two thousand shares of said stock not being subscribed for at the expiration of the said three days, in the manner hereinafter provided, that then, and in that event the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and empowered to cause said books to be reopened at such times or places as they, or a majority of them shall think proper, until the managers of the company are elected, in the manner herein-
