

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners shall cause to be made out a plot of the lot of ground so surveyed, laid out and condemned, to be by them lodged in the office of the clerk of Worcester county, as an authentic evidence of said survey and condemnation. CHAP. 214.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall value and assess the damages sustained by any person or persons, whose lands may be affected by such survey and condemnation, and the damages so assessed as aforesaid, together with all the necessary expenses incurred for surveying, laying out, and condemning said lot of ground, shall be returned by the said commissioners to the levy court of Worcester county, to be by them levied and assessed on the assessable property of said county. Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of said commissioners or a majority of them, to offer the contract for building the bridge herein before ordered to be constructed, also to offer the contract for raising, repairing, or otherwise improving the said road on each side of the said bridge, in such manner as they the said commissioners, or a majority of them, shall think proper to direct, for the public safety and convenience, publicly in the town of Berlin, after they shall have given three weeks notice in the Borderer, published in Snow-Hill, to the lowest and best bidder, who shall give bond in a penalty double the amount of the contract, with security to be approved by the commissioners or a majority of them, for the construction and completion of said bridge, and the raising, repairing and improving said road in a durable and workmanlike manner. Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the aforesaid commissioners or a majority of them, to cause to be made and executed a good and sufficient foot-way across the stream commonly called Middle Branch, where the public road leading from Lemuel and William Shewell's store, to the dwelling house of said William Shewell crosses said stream, and to offer the contract for the making and erecting the said footway, in the same manner and at the same place, and with the same provisions as they are directed and required to offer the contracts for constructing the bridge and road, by the fifth section of this act. Sec. 7. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the aforesaid commissioners, or a majority of them, after contracting for the building and completion of said bridge, and the raising, repairing and improving said road, and for
