

CHAPTER 222.

CHAP. 222.

A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act to authorise a Lottery to raise a sum of money for the purpose of finishing the Roman Catholic Church, in Frederick Town, Frederick County. Passed Mar. 19, 1834

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Maryland has, by the act to which this act is a further supplement, granted a lottery for the purposes in said original act mentioned; and whereas, in consequence of the death or removal of the commissioners heretofore appointed, the said lottery has not been drawn, and in order to perfect such grant heretofore made, it is necessary that new commissioners should be appointed by the Legislature;—Therefore,

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the pastor and members of the Roman Catholic Congregation in Fredericktown, shall be entitled to the full benefit of the act of eighteen hundred and three, chapter seven. Preamble
Act revived

Sec 2. *And be it enacted,* That Edward A. Lynch, Francis Lueber, and John McElroy, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, authorised to carry into effect the provisions of the said original act, and of this supplement. Commissioners

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That a majority of said commissioners shall be, and they are hereby authorised to create a scheme or schemes for the Lottery herein referred to; also, to draw the same, and to sell tickets for that end; and in their discretion, to dispose of the whole right herein granted to draw said Lottery, and further, to do whatever may be convenient or necessary to carry into effect the provisions of the said original act, and of this supplement; and that any person or persons, purchasing of the aforementioned commissioners the right to said lottery, shall be invested with all the authority herein bestowed upon said commissioners; *Provided,* that the sum of ten thousand dollars, and no more, be raised by any such scheme or schemes; *and provided further,* that any and every scheme proposed by virtue of this act, shall, before the drawing of the same, be approved by the commissioners of lotteries. Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That the proceeds arising from the sale or drawing of said lottery, shall be applied by the commissioners herein named, towards the completion of the Catholic Church now being erected in Fredericktown, and to insure the faithful application of such receipts, the said Proceeds applied
