fore the first day of November next, who shall record such CHAP. 251. of said reports in his office, as may be received by him on Record thereof or before that day; and every commissioned officer of the militia of this State, who shall not report himself on or before said day, shall be deemed, and by the adjutant general be recorded, as having vacated his office and forfeited once vacated in his commission; and the Governor and Council shall then, neglected or soon afterwards, appoint and commission suitable persons, being citizens of the United States and of this State, others to be apto fill the vacancies hereby occasioned, or which shall oth. pointed erwise exist or happen; and there shall be appointed and commissioned one adjutant general and one quarter master General start general in the militia of this State; to each division of said militia, one major general, and two aids-de-camp, with the rank of major, one inspector of, and one quarter master of division, to each brigade, one brigadier general, with inspector, to serve also as a brigad major, and one quarter master of brigade, to rank as majors; to each regiment, one Regimental officers colonel, one lieutenant colonel, and one major, and a regimental staff, to consist of one adjutant and one quarter master, to rank as lieutenants; one paymaster, one surgeon, and one surgeon's mate, one chaplain, one sergeant major. one drum major, and one fife major; to each entra battalion, Extra battalion or squadron, one major, and the same staff officers as a regiment hath; to each company of infantry or riflemen, one Common officers captain, one first lieutenant, and one second heutenant; to each company of artillery, one captain, and two lieutenants, and to each company of cavalry, one captain, and two lieutenants; and, whenever the office of major general, brigadier general, colonel, licutenant colonel, major, captain, or case of vacancy lieutenant, shall be vacant, the officer next in rank shall ex- Duti to be perereise the command, and perform the duties thereof, until found by the next in glade the vacancy shall be supplied.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That out of the militia of Proportion of riflethis State, enrolled as in this act directed, there shall be formed for each battalion, at least one company of rifle-or early men, or light infantry; and that to each brigade there shall be at least one company of artillery, and four troops of Orartillery horse.

And whereas, sundry corps of artillery, riflemen, and Preamble cavalry, and light infantry, have been organized, uniformed, and equipped in this State, and attached to the general militia, or formed into separate and independent brigades, regiments, and battalions, and squadrons,—Therefore
