the adjutant general's cell on the filed therein; and at every char. 251 parade or meeting or each commany for inspection, the number and condition o the arms and accontrements in Notes contains spected, and those possessed by absent members within the browledge of said communities officer, shall be carriedly noted; and the said officers shall cause the same to be entered in the company book afterestid, discriminating such as belong to the State from such as belong to individuals, within three days after such inspection; and shall also, within ten days thereafter, transmit, by mail, a copy of such entry, to the adjutant general's office, to be recorded General record

therein.

Sec. 49. And be it engel of, That all uniform companies uniform directed and corps that may be hereafter formed, and those which now exist, and may remin their organization, shall adopt the uniform hereby established; the first when they form, and the latter at the expiration of four years from the passage of this act; and if any officer shall neglect or refuse to uniform himself, agreeably to the provisions of this act, he shall be eashiered or fined, for the first offence, not exceed. Per type nor ing fifty dollars, in the discretion of such court marrial as the case may require, and a further sum of fine dollars for the like neglect, for every paralla succeeding the decision of the court martial imposing said fine; and the commanding officer of any such company shall forthwith erase the name of each member thereor, who shall neglect or refuse to a lopt or provide himself with, and appear in the uniform penalty for not appear in the uniform of his company, as required by this act, and the company by-laws consistent herewith, for two succeeding parades; and he shall then forth with hand over the names of such delinquents to the communities, officer of the company district militia, or to serve in the draughted company, in which he should serve, if he should be a volunteer, under a ponalty of twenty dollars for each and every neglect of said officer, to be imposed on him or such court martial as the case may require, and collected and paid over by the proper sheriff, as other fines are directed to be, by this act; and that it shall be the duty of every commissioned officer to decreasequired to arm himself as shall be prescribed by the commander in arm chief of the militia of this State.

Sec. 41. And be it enacted, That each extra battalion or sing of extra batsquadron, shall have the same stan officers appointed, commissioned, and attached thereto, as are attached to a regiment.
