

He is directed to pay over and account for other fines, by this act.

Sec. 72. *And be it enacted*, That any officer, non-commissioned officer, musician or private, of the militia of this State, shall be disabled while in the service of this State, shall, as a remuneration for the injury that he may have received, be entitled to half pay; and the same shall be paid to him by the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in the manner and under the regulations prescribed for the case, in and by an act of the General Assembly, passed at the December session, eighteen hundred and fourteen, chapter one hundred and thirteen.

Sec. 53. *And be it enacted*, in addition to the many other advantages which would result from clothing the militia of this State, by a uniform, that the uniform of the militia of this State shall be, for general officers, blue frock coat, and buff breeches; for captains, long dark blue coat, lined with buff, buff breeches and cuffs, yellow buttons and buff under breeches, buff boots and chapeaux-de-bras; for field company and staff officers, long dark blue coat, edged with red, red collars and cuffs, white buttons, dark blue pantaloons, edged with red for winter, and white for summer; black gaiters, or buff boots, chapeaux-de-bras and black coxade; for non-commissioned officers, and privates, short dark blue coat, red cuffs and revers, white buttons, blue pantaloons, buff gaiters or buff boots; for the men, dark green frock or hunting shirt, and trousers; for cavalry, short coat and pantaloons of dark blue cloth, edged with red, buff boots, a helmet or cap of leather, such as are worn by the United States Dragoon; for artillery, long dark blue coat, lined with red, red collar and cuffs, yellow buttons, buff pantaloons, buff gaiters or buff boots, and chapeaux-de-bras.

Sec. 54. *And be it enacted*, That the Governor, by and with the consent of the Council, for the accommodation and support of the militia at any time called into actual service, may appoint such commissaries and staff officers as may seem proper, and shall have power to adopt such measures as may be deemed necessary for procuring, transporting and issuing all requisite supplies; and when supplies shall be so provided for any militia called into actual service, the officer commanding them, shall have full power and authority to procure, transfer and issue necessary supplies to the corps under his command; and whenever calls are made upon the militia, by the governor, such calls shall be made
