CHAPTER 271.

*A further supplement to an act, entitled, an act authorising gates to be kept on the public roads, in Queen Anne's County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty four, chapter one hundred and sixty seven.*

Passed Mar. 4, 1834

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the tax provided to be laid by the fourth section of the act to which this is a further supplement, shall be two dollars and fifty cents, instead of the sum of eight dollars, as provided by the fourth section as aforesaid.

CHAPTER 272.

*An act relating to the payment of the Crier and Bailiffs, of Baltimore County Court.*

Passed Feb. 24, 1834

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be the duty of the commissioners of Baltimore county, to cause to be levied, at the time of making the levy for the county charge, in the year eighteen hundred and thirty five, the amount which said commissioners shall estimate will become payable to the Crier and Bailiffs respectively, of Baltimore County Court, for their services during the years eighteen hundred and thirty five and eighteen hundred and thirty six, besides the amount then to be levied according to the law as now provided for the services of the said Crier and Bailiffs, and at every annual levy thereafter, it shall be the duty of the said commissioners to cause to be levied, the amount which they shall estimate will become payable as aforesaid, for the services aforesaid, for and during the then succeeding year.
