## CHAPTER 281.

In we to permit their lines, To eviors, and Touclett, to remove their State or District, to here and work, and met for sale.

Section 1. By it engeled by the General Assembly of Mass whomes as ryland, That from and after the passage of this act, all Guardians, Executors, and Trustees, heretotore or hereafter appointed, or any one of them, residing in this State, appointed by last will and testament, or otherwise, in this State, or any adjoining State or District, are hereby authorised and permitted to bring into this State, from any adjoining State or District, any slave or slaves, being slaves for life, confided to them in trust, and the same to hire out and work, from time to time, for the benefit of the persons con-respondent nected with the trust, and not for sale, and the same to remove back to any actolining State or District, at discretion, and back again to this State, from any adjoining State or District; Provided, that a list of such slaves shall be made to and recorded out by said guardian, executors, or trustees, or any one of quast them, within there days after their removal, and recorded in the clerk's office in the county to which said slaves may be, at any time, removed under this act.

Sec. 2. And he is charted. That no slave or slaves, some acceptionant into this State, under, and by virtue or this actionshall be entitled to free and thereby, any law to the contrary

notwithstanding.
