Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the trustees aforesaid CHAP. 287. shall be, and they are hereby required to hold the proceeds Trusters duties arising from the said sale and distribution, in trust, for the following purposes:—First, to pay the treasurer the said amount of five per cent. charged thereon—secondly, to pay off and discharge all or any hens due and chargeable unon said property, or any part thereof, and the residue to pay over to the trustee of the wife of the said George Winchester, for her sole and separate use, and agreeably to her legal and equitable title and interest therein.

CHAPTER 286.

A supplement to the act, entitled an act for the spredy trial raised Marile, 1835 of Criminals, and ascertaining their punishment, in the County Courts, when prosecuted there, and for the Payment of Fees due from Criminal Persons, passed at April session, seventeen hundred and fifteen, chapter twentysix.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Repeal the eighth section of the act, to which this is a supplement, be, and the same is hereby repealed, as to all persons charged with criminal offences, who shall be acquitted, or be discharged from prosecution, or who shall be admitted to and give bail upon such charges.

CHAPTER 287.

An act to authorise an exchange of certain Grounds therein Passed Marie 20.1831 mentioned.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary- Person to great land, That upon the petition of James Howard McHenry, by his guardian, the judges of the Orphans' court for Baltimore county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered to appoint three discreet and disinterested persons, who shall examine and report to said court, whether it would be for the benefit and advantage of James Howard McHenry, a minor, that parts of certain grounds belonging
