things, as to them it shall or may appertain to do.

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the objects for which objects this company is incorporated, is hereby declared to be, to guard and protect property endangered by fire, or any other cause.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the power is hereby reserved to the General Assembly, to repeal, alter, or amend this act, whenever and so often as they may deem proper.

CHAPTER 307.

An act to Divorce Rosanna Artinson, of Washington County, Passed Manageritiss from her husband, Eli Artinson.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Divorce land, That Rosanna Artinson, of Washington county, be, and she is hereby divorced from bed, board, and mutual co-habitation with her husband, Eli Artinson.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Eli Artinson Landilled shall not be liable for any debt to be hereafter contracted by the said Rosanna Artinson, nor be entitled to any property or estate which she may hereafter acquire.
