CHAP. 327.

*An act to repeal an act, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty three, chapter two hundred and nine, so far as relates to Anne Arundel County.* Passed Mar 21, 1834

WHEREAS, it appears that the act passed at December Possible session, eighteen hundred and thirty three, chapter two hundred and nine, entitled, an act to lay out and open a new road in Anne Arundel and Montgomery counties, is not in conformity with the petition praying for the passage of said act, so far as the same relates to Anne Arundel county, and has given great dissatisfaction to the citizens in that part of Anne Arundel county, as expressed in their petition for the repeal of said act, so far as the same relates to Anne Arundel county, Therefore:

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Repeal, &c. the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty three, chapter two hundred and nine, entitled, an act to lay out and open a new road in Anne Arundel and Montgomery counties, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as the same relates to Anne Arundel county, save and except so much of said road as runs from Brown's Ford, on the Patuxent river, to the lime kilns, in Anne Arundel county.

CHAPTER 327.

*An act to Incorporate a Company for constructing a floating Bridge over the Middle Branch of Patuxent River, in Baltimore County.* Passed Mar 21, 1834

Section I. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Michael Warner, Cumberland Dugan, William Krebs, Alexander Gould and John S. Gittings, be and they hereby are appointed commissioners for the purposes hereinafter mentioned, with power to supply any vacancy that may occur by death, resignation, or otherwise; that is to say, Vacancies they, or a majority of them, after ten days notice in two or Notice more of the daily newspapers printed in the city of Baltimore, shall or may open a book or books, in such place or Grounds places as they may designate, for raising subscriptions to
