*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Louis Gassaway, eight dollars, for two days attendance as clerk to the House of Delegates, this session, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.*

Passed Feb. 4.

Resolution in favor of the trustees of St. Paul's Chapel Free School, of Charles County.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Orphans' Court of Charles county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to draw upon the Treasurer of the Western Shore, in favor of the trustees of Saint Paul's Chapel Free School, of Charles county, for two hundred dollars, of the Free School Fund for said county, for the year eighteen hundred and thirty four.*

*Resolved, That the Orphans' Court of Charles county, be authorised to draw upon the Treasurer of the Western Shore, for, and pay over annually to, the Trustees of St. Paul's Chapel Free School, in Charles county, two hundred dollars, out of that portion of the avails of the free school fund heretofore directed to be invested annually for the benefit of Charles county; Provided, said Orphans' Court shall be satisfied that twenty five poor children of said county have the privilege of being instructed annually in said school.*
