Resolution requesting the Governor to procure and present a sword to Captain Edmond P. Kennedy.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That his Excellency the Governor, procure a sword with suitable devices and ornaments, and present it in the name of the State, to Commodore Edmond P. Kennedy, of the United States Navy, as a testimony of the high sense entertained by his native State, of his distinguished and gallant services to his country, in the memorable action with the Tripolitan gun boats off Tripoli, in August, eighteen hundred and four.
