Resolution in favor of William H. Baldwin, of Anne Arundel County.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby authorised and required, to pay William H. Baldwin, of Anne Arundel county, or to his order, two months pay, due his mother, Maria Gambrill, deceased, upon the pension list of this State.
