CHAPTER 33.

Passed Jan. 24, 1835 *An act to authorise the Burgess and Commissioners of the Town of Williamsport, in Washington county, to lease, let, sell, or otherwise dispose of a certain lot or parcel of ground in said Town.*

Authority to sell **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the burgess and commissioners of the town of Williamsport, in Washington county, be, and are hereby, authorized to sell, let, lease, or otherwise dispose of, a certain piece or parcel of ground in said town, and lying on the south side of Potomac street, and the west side of Commerce street, and commonly known as “the public square.”

Proceeds applied **Sec. 2.** *And be it further enacted,* That the money accruing from the rents and profits thereof, shall be for the use and benefit of said town, and may be appropriated by the said Burgess and Commissioners, as shall seem best calculated to promote the general good of the town.

Notice required **Sec 3.** *And be it enacted,* That in case the Burgess and Commissioners aforesaid, shall determine to sell the property above described, they shall give at least thirty days notice in some newspaper printed in Washington county.
