No. 76.

Resolution in relation to Hester Penefield.

Passed Mar. 20, 1835

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Hester Penefield, widow of Thomas Penefield, a soldier of the revolution, the half pay of a private, in quarterly payments, during her widowhood.

No. 77.

Resolution in favor of William Glover.

Passed Mar. 21,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Glover, twenty eight dollars, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury, for his services in the house of delegates as extra clerk.

No. 78.

Resolution in favor of William Welch.

Passed Mar. 21,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Welch, eight dollars, the per diem for two days omitted on the journal, out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.

No. 79.

Resolution relative to publishing certain Laws.

Passed Mar. 21,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and Council be requested to publish such laws, of public nature, as they deem necessary, in one newspaper in each county in this State, in which a paper is published, and in two newspapers in the city of Baltimore,
