Resolution in favor of William S. Hambleton.

Passed Mar 21, 1835

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William S. Hambleton, eight dollars, the per diem for two days, omitted on the journal; John L. Dorsey, one day; Samuel Sutton, for one day; out of any unappropriated money in the treasury.

Resolution in favor of Brookville Academy.

Passed Mar. 14

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be authorised and directed to pay to the trustees of Brookville Academy, in Montgomery county, or their order, the sum of two hundred dollars, which shall become due on the first day of April next, in virtue of this resolution, and annually, thereafter, the same sum.

Resolved, That the trustees of Brookville Academy shall be, and are hereby required to comply with the requisition of the act of eighteen hundred and twenty three, chapter one hundred and forty one, in the same manner as other academies, receiving donations from the State, are now required.

Resolution relative to the Banks in the City of Baltimore.

Passed Mar, 21,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the whole amount of the tax of twenty cents in the hundred dollars, of the capital actually paid in, or to be paid in, of the several Banks in the city of Baltimore, the charters of which are extended by the act of the present session, entitled, an act to extend the charters of the several Banks in the city of Baltimore, shall, as the same may come into the treasury, be applied as directed by the ninth section of the
