*Resolved*, That before any contract is entered into, as hereinbefore provided, the clerk of the Executive Council shall advertise, for at least three weeks, in two daily papers published in the city of Baltimore, for proposals to contract for making the repairs above required, stating particularly the nature of the work to be performed, and in what manner, and out of the proposals received, the Executive shall select that which, in their judgment, will be most advantageous, and shall require the person or persons so engaged, to enter bond for the faithful performance of the contract.
