

113. A supplement to an act, entitled, an act to incorporate certain trustees to build an academy or school house, in or near the town of Manchester, in Baltimore county, to be known by the name and style of the Manchester United Academy, or school.

114. An act to repeal all that part of the constitution and form of government, as relates to the division of Washington county, into eight separate election districts, and for other purposes.

115. An act to divorce William B. Everett, of Kent county, from his wife Emily Everett, otherwise called Emily F. Everett.

116. A further supplement to the act, entitled, an act to provide for the election of commissioners for Washington county, and prescribing their powers and duties.

117. An act for the benefit of Robert Roach, of the city of Baltimore.

118. An act for the relief of Thomas Perry, late sheriff and collector of Charles county

119. An act to regulate the sale of ardent spirits, within the village of Salisbury, in Somersat and Worcester counties.

120. An act to provide for the inspection of flour, lumber and coals, in the town of Williamsport, in Washington county.

121. An act to alter and amend the lines dividing the seventh and eighth election districts, in Baltimore county.

122. An act to change a part of the divisional line between the fourth and fifth election districts, in Worcester county.

123. An act to alter and amend a road in Harford and Baltimore counties, leading from the upper cross roads, in Harford county, to Baltimore city.

124. An additional supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to free negroes and slaves, passed at December session, 1831, chapter 323.

125. An act to alter the time for holding the levy court of Prince George's county, for the purpose of hearing appeals and noting transfers of property, and for increasing the pay of the members of said court.

126. An act relating to the computation of the stay of execution on judgments.

127. An act relating to two public roads, No. 6 and No. 48, in Queen Anne's county.

128. An act to authorise William H. D. C. Wright, to bring into this State certain slaves therein named.
