cessary cases for the reception of the public records, and with all necessary furniture for the accommodation of Worcester county court, members of the bar and public offices, and with such other things as their convenience may require: which Court House and offices when so built and furnished, shall be under the control and superintendance of the Levy court of Worcester county.

Authorized to sell,
&c.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to sell and dispose of such part or parts of the remains of the Court House recently destroyed by fire as they may deem proper, and to apply the avails arising therefrom to the construction and furnishing the said Court House and offices; and to borrow from time to time and upon such terms as they may deem proper, at a rate of interest not exceeding six per cent per annum, any sum or sums of money that may be required and found necessary for the construction and furnishing the said Court House and offices, provided the same shall not exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars.

Borrow money

Levy directed

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Levy court of Worcester county are hereby authorised and required to levy annually upon the assessable property of Worcester county, such sum or sums of money as they in their judgment may deem best, not exceeding the sum of two thousand dollars, nor less than fifteen hundred dollars, until the whole sum which the said commissioners or a majority of them may require for the construction of the said Court House and offices shall have been levied and collected, provided the same shall not exceed the sum of ten thousand dollars.

In name of commissioners

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all levies imposed or authorised by this act, shall be levied and imposed in the name of the said commissioners, and payable only to their order, or the order of a majority of them.

Bond required

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the said commissioners, or such of them as may undertake to execute the powers vested in them by this act, shall before they proceed to execute the same, give bond to the State of Maryland, in the penal sum of twenty thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful execution of the trust hereby reposed in them, which bond shall be lodged with the clerk of Worcester county, a certified copy of which shall be received as evidence in any court of law or equity in this state.

Sec. 6. *And be it enacted*, That in case either of the said commissioners shall die or resign or refuse to act, the other
