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CHAPTER 54.

*A Supplement to an act, entitled, an act to Incorporate the Woodsborough Savings Institution, passed December session, eighteen hundred and thirty two, chapter one hundred and nine.* Passed Feb. 9, 1835

WHEREAS, it appears to this General Assembly, that the Directors of the Woodsborough Savings Institution, omitted or neglected to appoint from the members of said corporation, three competent persons as a committee of examiners, agreeably to the provisions of the fifth section thereof;

AND WHEREAS, said Institution are apprehensive that some loss, inconvenience, or difficulty might arise from said omission, Therefore:

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said Woodsborough Savings Institution shall not suffer any loss, detriment, trouble or inconvenience, by reason of any omission or neglect heretofore, of the said institution to appoint from the members of the said institution, three competent persons as a committee of examiners, agreeably to the fifth section of the charter of said institution, and the said institution, notwithstanding any such omission or neglect heretofore, shall hereafter appoint a committee of examiners, agreeably to the fifth section of the charter of said institution. CHAPTER 55.

*An act for the Incorporation of Caroline Lodge, Number twenty two, of the order of Independent Odd Fellows, in Caroline County.* Passed Feb. 9, 1835

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That James B. Rumbold, James B. Wilson, Thomas E. Corporation created
