

Whereupon the said Daniel Anderson at the prayer of the sp. Alexander Stuart is adjudged to give special bail to the action of Tharupon a certain Joseph Knabbe of Somerset County Plaintiff present herein Court in his proper Person under bond for the said Daniel Anderson and answered upon himself that if it should happen that judgment in the Plea of the said Daniel Anderson should be rendered for the said Alex. Stuart against the sp. Daniel Anderson or that he the said Daniel should be therein convicted that then he the said Daniel should pay and satisfy unto the sp. Alexander Stuart the judgment of the Court Tharupon or under his Lady's execution of such judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff of the County of sp. in Satisfaction thereof that he the said Joseph Knabbe will do the same for him

And the sp. Daniel Anderson in his proper Person Cometh and defendeth the same and praying that the Court should deny the action of the sp. Alex. Stuart on but that he did defend upon himself in manner and form as the sp. Alex. above against him hath complained and unto the Damage of the said Alex. by him by Omission of the Premises in that Part sustained the same Daniel Smith and Acknowledged that the sp. Alex. hath sustained Damages by Omission of the Premises beyond his Cost and Charges by him about his Suit in that Part appoynted to five pound One Shilling and Eleven pence of Money and not more and because the sp. Alex. demandeth that the same Allegation ought to be true prayer judgment for these Damages above Acknowledged together with his Cost and charges of sp. to him to be adjudged Therefore by Consent of the parties of this Court considered that the sp. Alex. Stuart recover against the sp. Daniel Anderson his Damages of the sp. five pound One Shilling and Eleven pence of Money by the same Daniel in full of sp. Acknowledged as also

W. Ballist by W. Stoyard his Attorney and the Sheriff said John Dennis G. b. now here returned that he had taken the sp. W. South whose body here at this day he had the sp. W. Ballist of the sp. Plea unto him was Comanded

Whereupon the said W. South put in his place Sir Dennis G. b. Attorney at Law against the sp. W. Ballist of the sp. Plea And thereupon at the prayer of the Parties of Day is to them now here given until next Court to be held at Quinners Lane from the third Tuesday of August then next following that the said William South should be safe kept and that he should have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Quinners Lane from the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini thousand seven hundred and Sixty Eight unto William Ballist of Ayles who for with force and arms he the said William South in and upon the sp. William Ballist at Somerset County of an assault did make and him the said W. Ballist then and there did beat wound and lilly hurt so that of his Life it was much impaired and other harms to the said William Ballist and against the peace of the Right which the said King by his Good Rule and Government and defendeth
