Our four Justices of our said Court the 22 day of November Anno Domini 1760

At which day here came the said John & James by W. Stoyard their Attorney and the Sheriff his John Dennis
Court now here Returned that he had by virtue of the Writ of it Made known unto the said Signey Brown by John Gosham and
Hugh Carter good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick that he be and appear before the Justice within mentioned on the day and
place within mentioned to show Cause as within to him it was Commanded

And the said Signey Brown by George Stoyard his Attorney comes and prays Leave thereof to appear here at the
next Court to be held at Princes Ann Town the third Tuesday of June then next following and he hath it and the said day is given
to the said John & James here also

At which day here came as well the said John & James as the said Signey Brown by their
Attorneys of and hereupon the said Signey prays for the Leave thereof to appear here on the next Court to be held at
Princes Ann Town the third Tuesday of August then next following and he hath it and the said day is given to the said John
& James here also

At which day here came as well the said John & James as the said Signey by their Attorneys of
and hereupon the said Signey saith that he cannot deny but that the said John & James ought to have Execution
against him the said Signey according to the tenor of the Executions of it. Therefore it is considered that the said John & James
and James Truburn have Execution against the said Signey Brown of the Damages of it in the sum of £100.00. And also
it is considered that the said John & James Receive against the said Signey

114 John White } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John Dushill out of
of John Dushill } Somerset County otherwise called of John Dushill of Somerset County that if he should be
found in his Bailiwick and him should be taken so that he might have his body before the Justice of the said County Court
of Somerset to be held at Princes Ann Town the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini 1761 to answer unto John White of Lynton that he should pay him the sum of fifty pounds Sterling and the same cost Money of
Maryland which to him he does and unjustly detains and saith that the said day is given to the said John White here

At which day here came the said John White by William Allen his Attorney and the Sheriff his John Dennis
Court now here Returned that he had taken the said John Dushill whose body he had taken to answer the said John White of
the said plea unto him it was Commanded

Whereupon the said John Dushill at the Charge of the said John White is adjured
to give special Bail to the Action of it. Thereupon certain Joseph Allen of Somerset County hath presented herein set in his
Charge Dushill and that of the said John Dushill and adjured upon himself that if it should happen that the said John
Dushill should be taken for the said John White against the said John Dushill that he the said John Dushill should
therein convict that then he the said John Dushill should pay and satisfy unto the said John White the Judgment of the Court
thereupon a Return his body in Execution of such Judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff of the County of it in satisfaction
thereof that he the said Joseph Allen will do the same for him

And thereupon at the Charge of the Justice of it is to them here given until next Court to be held at
Princes Ann Town the third Tuesday of June then next following in the State that was shewing to the Justice of it
