The Deposition of Abel Milburn aged fifty five years or thereabouts being sworn on the holy Evangelic of Almighty God Depoent as followeth (to wit) that John Coffey told him the Depoent that John Milburn and Samuel Collins did share by Right when they were bound by Major Surgeon Wheelby and Major Wilson and Capt Samuel Wilson to where a Cedar Post had stood on the same Place where there is now a Stage - Depoent he and this Depoent Smith he made known and said he believed they did share Right for the Depoent Smith he and Capt William Holland did see some Pine trees from where it was said the Cedar post - stood and the said John Coffey told him the Depoent the Line of Made trees went South - East thereof and that there was an Oak Line that Robert Boyer made a certain Line in 1740 between Capt. D. and Major Wilson and this Depoent Smith he asked the said Coffey what Wood with Cedar Post and he said that the Cedar Post was fixed there for and he said that his Mother told him that it was set down where a Bounder of Whites - Land stood that was dead and the Depoent further said that -

The Deposition of John Milburn aged fifty six years or thereabouts being sworn on the holy Evangelic of Almighty God Depoent as followeth (to wit) that he saw a Made White Oak standing near the same Place and near the Mouth of a small Run near to a small Stage Pine which is a small Distance Eastly from Elias White fence which is partly made with White Oak of Timber commonly called and known by the name of the Water Wood and Capt William Holland told this Depoent it was a bounder between W. White and Howard and further this Depoent declares that that further Down the same or Day Side on the land of the high Land near to where there is now a Stage Depoent tree he saw a Cedar Post made with sixteen Notches and Smith he was told by Jacob Deane and John Milburn that it was a bounder between the said Land and Michael Coffey Land and this Depoent further said that -
