the said Elizabeth then and there did beget to the high displeasure of Almighty God the birth sample of all mankind
in such Case Offending Against the Peace of the said Lord Proprietary that now is his Good Rule and Government and
Contrary to the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case made and Provided and Left —
That he should take the said Anthony Collins —

Thereupon it is Commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take the Said Anthony Collins
if he Should be found in his Brigwich and him Should safe keep so that he might have his Body before the Justices
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Princes Ann Towne the third Tuesday of August Ann'd
glor to answer unto his Said Lordship of and concerning the Indictment aforesay'd and the aforesaid Sheriff
at the same Day return'd that he had taken the aforesaid Anthony Collins as by the writ has or can be made but the
Said Sheriff at the same Day al the solemnly called bringes not in the Body of the same ^{Anthony} according to the
Return of the Processt aforesaid made Default Thereupon Day is Given by the Court here unto the aforesaid Sheriff and the
Court also held at Princes Ann Towne in and for the County aforesay'd the third Tuesday of November then next ensuing
for the bringing in of the Said Anthony Collins to Answer aforesaid the Penalty of being Imprisoned Thirty Shillings per
Money of Maryland and Paying all fees & expenses due by reason of the Prosecution aforesay'd

Whereas all and Singular the Premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood it
is Considered by the Court here that the P. Anthony Collins for the Premises and others P. in the judgment of
the Court above specified to take which said Anthony Collins present herein Court in his proper person is bound for the
P. & D. Off. of the sum of thirty Pounds which was paid to the Plaintiff the man of the County of

Whereupon the said Anthony Collins present herein Court in his Proper Person in Oorangulo Esq.
Secretary to Law and Law Indemnified the Justices of Somersett County Court from all Costs Charges and Troubles that
may accrue by reason of the Birth of the Bastard Child aforesaid. Whereupon a Captain James Quatermaine of Somersett
County Plantation present herein Court in his Proper Person under his Hand & Seal the said Anthony C. Collins and his Landholder
himself to be Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Twenty Pounds Sterling Money of Maryland for his
body Goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to be made and Seized if it happen that the said James Quatermaine should
Leave and Law Indemnified the Justices of Somersett County Court from all such Charges and Troubles that may accrue by
Reason of the birth of the Bastard Child aforesaid. At the 13 day of Decr: 1720.

Ch. Henderson body of men at Conwy upon their Oath present that Chas. L. Henderson late of Shropsey Esqch in the
County of Shropsey on the twelveth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty one
with force and arms at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and upon a certain journeie thither in the year of God
and ther had land Proprietary ther and there being an affront did make and him the said James ther and ther did
