Against him the said Burnell according to the force and Effect of the Procees of. of the Sheriff think fit and further to do and Receive what our same Court shall thinke and there Consider of concerning him in this behalfe and have you then and there the Names of them by whom to him you shall Give notice and the Writ of Habeas Corpus Indene for Justices of your said Court the 20 day of August in the 11th year of Dominion of our same King 1661

Mentioned according to the force and Effect of the Procees of. Also it is considered that the said Nicholas McCubbin Recover Against the said Burnell Naisled for his Costs and Charges sustained by means of the delay of the Execution of the Judgment of. and that the said Nicholas have thereof Execution of.
