

By Virtue of the foregoing Account Return and Warrant was issued the following Attachment Against the Goods Chattels and Credits of Henry Callwell as follows

Summ't for Frederick Absolute and Prop' of the Business of Maryland and Avalon and Baron of Baltimore to the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting We Command you that you Attach any the Goods Chattels and Credits of Henry Callwell Late of Somerset County in the Breaches make if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value of three pounds Nine Shillings and Money and five hundred pounds of Tobacco When you have the same Attached or any part thereof the same in your custody take Care that you have the same before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Princes Anne Town the third Tuesday of Next next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to be used for the use of a certain Levin Wallard unless the said Henry Callwell by himself or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said Levin Wallard in a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. according to Law and that by good and Lawfull Men of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment that he she or they be and appear before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held as aforesaid to show Cause if any he she or they have why the same Goods Chattels and Credits be Attached in his her or their hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such Case made and provided if to him here then it shall be as most and how you shall execute this Writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the day and place aforesaid and have you there this Writ with you for your Stand by before our Justice of our said Court the 20 Day of August Anno Domini 1761

Which said third Tuesday of November came the said Levin Wallard in his proper person and the Sheriff sent John Dennis Esq. to receive the said Writ of Attachment returned in the Manner following with a Schedule thereunto annexed - Summ't for Henry Callwell to the Justice within named that I have Attached of the Goods and Chattels of the within Henry Callwell the sum of three pounds Nine Shillings and six pence of Money and also four hundred fifty seven and a half pounds of Tobacco as by the Schedule hereunto annexed for satisfying the Debt herein mentioned and I further Certify to the Justice of the said County that on the first Day of November 1761 I Attached in the hands of Robert Leathe Esq. of fifteen Shillings also in the hands of Arnold May Esq. three Shillings and in the hands of Mark Jones Esq. seven Shillings and in the hands of John Thomas Esq. fifteen Shillings and that John Thomas Esq. and the said Levin Wallard and Lawfull Men of your Bailiwick made known unto the said Justice and appear before the Justice within named at the day and place within named to show Cause if any of them have why the same shall be in each of their hands Attached should not be condemned for the purpose aforesaid
