unto the said John White His Ex<sup>ors</sup> adm<sup>ors</sup> or Certain Attorney, to which payment well  
and truly to be made & done We do bind ourselves & last of us our and every of our Heirs,  
Ex<sup>ors</sup> & adm<sup>ors</sup> firmly by these presents sealed with our seals & dated this 23<sup>rd</sup> Day of  
April Anno Domini seven hundred fifty and eight

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden Thomas  
Jones & Stevens White they or either of them do and shall well and truly pay or cause  
to be paid unto the aforesaid John White His Ex<sup>ors</sup> adm<sup>ors</sup> or assigns the full and  
Just sum of Twenty eight pounds Seventeen Shillings and Three pence Current money  
of Maryland together with the Legal Interest thereof till paid, then the above oblig-  
ation to be void & of none Effect. Else to be & remain in full Force & Virtue in Law
