Inventor & Proprietor of Datus Houston - One of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County of
James Houston and made Oath upon the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that he has Received no part or share
Satisfaction or Security for the Account aforesaid before W. Wilder _____
Somerset. Whereas it is Made appear to my Satisfaction by the Oath of James Houston that Daniel
Smith is fully indebted unto him in the sum of four pounds ten Shillings and Nine pence and hath Absconded
and fled from Justice and hath or is about to Remove his effects in Order to defraud his just Creditors -
These are therefore in his Lordships Name to Authorize and Require you to Issue an Attachment for
the said James Houston Against the Goods Chattels Rights and Credit of the aforesaid Daniel Smith for the sum
of four pounds ten Shillings and Nine pence with the Incident Costs thereon and this shall be yours -
Warrant Given under my hand and Seal the Nineteenth day of November in the Year of our Lord One thousand
Seven hundred and Sixty One W. Wilder

Somerset for Indemnity Absolute and Pro. of the Business of Maryland and Detainee & Person of
Baltimore &c To the Sheriff of Somerset County Greeting we Command you that you Attach Any the Goods Chattels
Credit of Daniel Smith Esq of Somerset County Planter if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the Value
of Two Pounds Ten Shillings and Nine pence CT Money and Five hundred Pounds of Tobacco and When you
have the same Attached or long Detain thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before
our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Princess Ann Town the third Tuesday of March
Next then and there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and for the use of Captain James Hardy
unless the said Daniel Smith by himself or his Attorney shall appear and answer unto the said James
Hardy in Capia of trespass and ^{for} according to Law and that by Good and Surefull men of your
Bailiwick you make known unto the Person or Persons in whose hands you make the same Attachment
that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset to be held as oft
the said cause of long as she or they have why the same Goods Chattels and Credit be Attached in his her or their
hands Ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly
in such Case made and provided if to him less than it shall seem meet and how you shall execute
the same that you make known unto our said Justices at the day and place aforesaid and how you then
here this 11th instant James Hardy Esq Chief Justice here did sign the 28th day of November

Hargan his Attorney and the Sheriff with John Wilson over here returned the said Writ of Attachment
